While there are several faith-based, outpatient treatment programs in Southeastern PA, REFUGE is the only faith-based counseling for adults in our region credentialed to accept Medicaid funds. We also accept all major regional coverages, including: Aetna, IndependenceBCBS, HighmarkBCBS, UnitedHealthCare, and Medicare.
